The Institute of Certified Public of Uganda (ICPAU) is the national Professional Accountancy Organisation.

ICPAU was established in 1992 by an Act of Parliament, now the Accountants Act, 2013. The functions of the Institute as prescribed by the Act, are: to regulate and maintain the standard of accountancy in Uganda; and to prescribe and regulate the conduct of accountants and practising accountants in Uganda. As part of its functions, the Institute is required to advise the government on matters of financial accountability, management, and economic policy in all sectors of the economy. The CPA Economic Forum is one of the avenues through which this function is executed.

The Economic Forum is a three-day event organised by ICPAU to provide a platform for accountants and other professionals to discuss matters shaping up national economic policy.
