Rwenzori Regional Members Network Launched

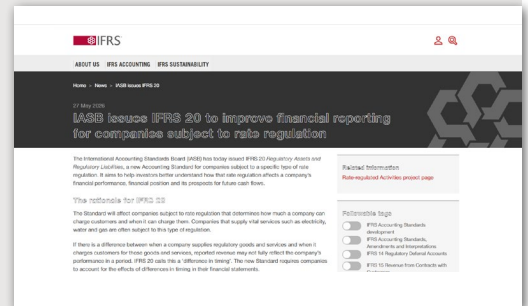

IASB Issues IFRS 20 to Improve Financial Reporting for Companies Subject to Rate Regulation

The International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) has issued [IFRS 20 Regulatory Assets and Regulatory Liabilities](#), a new accounting standard for companies subject to rate regulation. The standard, which replaces IFRS 14 Regulatory Deferral Accounts, is effective for annual reporting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2029.



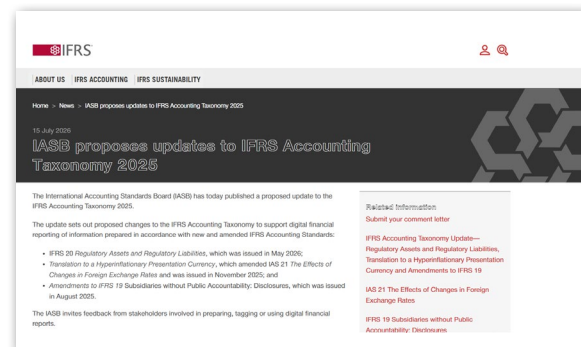
IFRS Foundation Proposes Updates to IFRS Accounting Taxonomy 2025

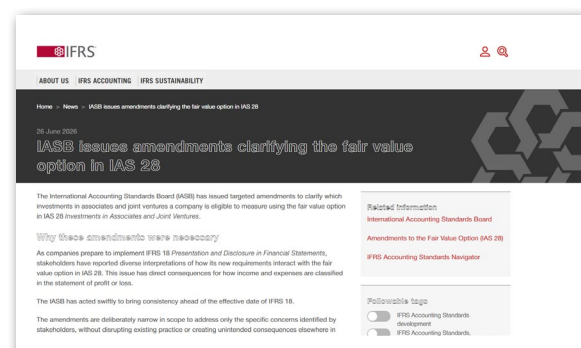
IASB Proposes Updates to IFRS Accounting Taxonomy 2025

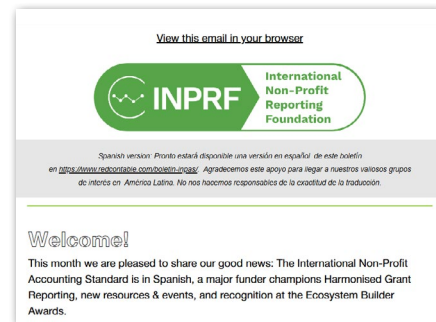
IASB Issues Amendments Clarifying the Fair Value Option in IAS 28

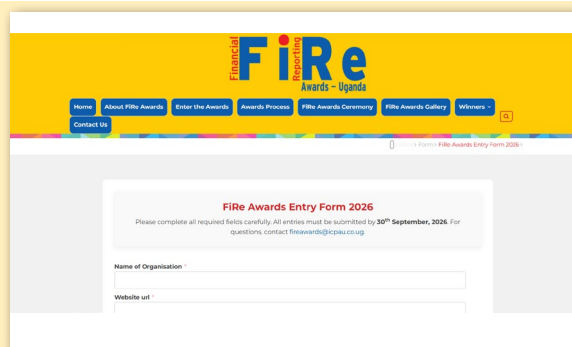
IPSASB SRS 1, Climate-related Disclosures

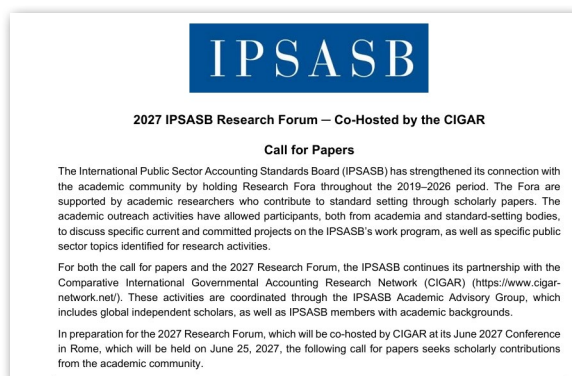
The 2026 FiRe Awards: Call for Entries

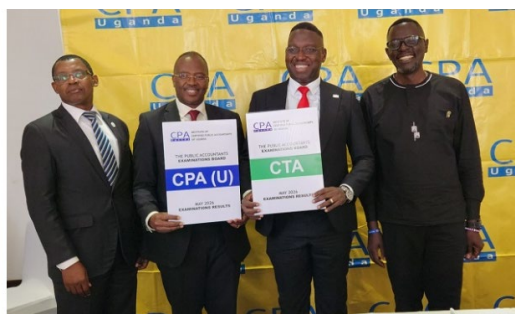

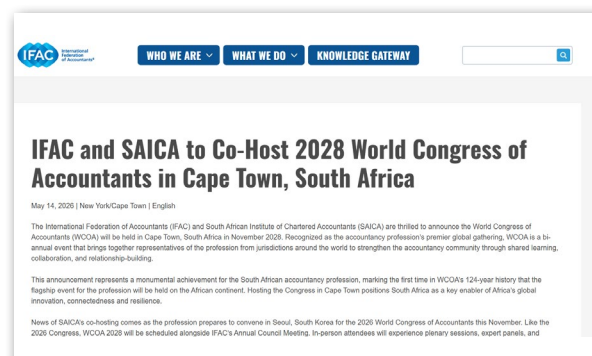
