# RELEASE OF MARCH 2021 EXAMINATIONS RESULTS THURSDAY, 1 APRIL 2021

#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

On behalf of the Public Accountants Examinations Board (PAEB) and on my own behalf, I wish to welcome you all to the release of results for the March 2021 examinations diet.

It is important to note that, this was the first time for PAEB to conduct examinations in March. The March 2021 examinations diet was introduced to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the year 2020 examinations calendar, where only one (1) examinations diet was conducted in December 2020. Indeed, the response indicates that it was the right thing to do.

Whereas, 3,381 students registered for the March 2021 examinations, 3,180 students turned up to attempt the examinations. We hope that many students' plans of completing the course are back in synch after the disruption occasioned by COVID-19 pandemic in the year 2020. Three (3) more examination diets this year are in

planned i.e. June, September and December, to avail more opportunities to students to complete their studies or in preparation for transition into the new syllabus to. Therefore, students are encouraged to take advantage of these diets.

#### 2.0 NEW SYLLABUSES

We reported about the new syllabuses at the release of the December 2020 examinations results. We wish to reiterate that our plan of having them rolled out in 2022 still stands. We are still committed to launching them later this year and be examinable in 2022.

#### 3.0 EXAMINATIONS RESULTS

The March 2021 examinations were conducted over a period of five days from Monday 15, to Friday 19 March 2021 at the Kampala examinations centre only.

A total of 3,180 students attempted the March 2021 examinations.

The students' performance in the individual subjects is given as follows:

The general pass rate for all candidates was at 36.4%.

In terms of gender, out of the 1,646 candidates who passed their papers, 849 (51.6%) were female while 797 (48.4%) were male.

It is also important to note that out of the 1,646 candidates who passed their papers, 509 (30.9%) were attempting them for the first time. We appreciate the level of preparedness of these candidates. It demonstrates that with determination and preparedness, the CPA course papers can be passed at first attempt.

In terms of age, 377 candidates (23.0%) were in the age bracket of 18 - 24 years, 629 (38.4%) in the 25-28 years age bracket, 333 (20.3%) in the 30-34 years age bracket and 144 (8.8%) in the 35-39 years age bracket. The remainder 154 (9.5%) were in age bracket of 40 years and above. The age brackets demonstrate a good pattern of youngsters picking up professionalism at early stages of their career which is good for the business community in the country.

Of the 136 candidates above, 63 (46.3%) were female while 73 (53.7%) were male.

This brings the number of students who have completed the CPA course to 4,132.
